

**NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO CLOSE CCR LANDFILL
LAKELAND ELECTRIC – C. D. MCINTOSH POWER PLANT
BYPRODUCT STORAGE AREA**

The Coal Combustion Residuals (CCR) Rule, 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 257 and 261, requires the owner or operator to provide a notification of the intent to close a CCR unit under the requirements of §257.102. Lakeland Electric is making notification of its intent to close the existing CCR landfill designated as Byproduct Storage Area at the C.D. McIntosh Power Plant located at 3030 East Lake Parker Drive in Lakeland, Polk County, Florida.
